Performs cleaning and disinfecting of all areas according to department policy and procedures. This includes restrooms, walls, windows, and hallways within the department. 2. Conducts floor maintenance according to policy and procedures. This includes sweeping, mopping, and vacuuming. 3. Performs laundry duties according to department policy and procedures. This includes sorting, washing, drying, folding, putting away, and mending. 4. Performs dietary aide duties according to department policy and procedures. This includes washing dishes, scrubbing the floor, setting up and delivering trays, preparing desserts, and serving meals at Senior Suites. 5.
