Must possess strong organization skills. Must be able to work independently. No previous experience is required, but preferred. Employee must be able to interact appropriately with patients and their family members. Must be able to answer questions or direct questions to the appropriate personnel. Must possess the ability to assess the patient and report to the patient's nurse.

## **Job Description**

The Nurse Aide/CNA performs patient care activities under the direction of the RN. Activities will vary with patient needs. Decisions affect patients, their families, physicians, and other staff members.

## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS, ROLES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Assist the nurses in admitting patients, taking vital signs, weights, and providing patient's and family member's information.
- 2. Demonstrates ability to take vital signs, AccuChecks and weights. Demonstrates ability to transfer patients using proper techniques.
- 3. Demonstrates ability to collect lab specimens correctly.
- 4. Completes necessary shift duties including, but not limited to, bedside shift reporting, updating whiteboards, hourly rounding, in-room documentation, and utilizes call light system per protocol.
- 5. Completes assignments independently, reporting needed information to the patient's nurse.
- 6. Assists the nurse in emergencies. Directs visitor traffic and phone calls.
- 7. Assists in the ER as an aide, as time allows.
- 8. Stocks supplies on the floor and in the ER, , as time allows.

## **OTHER DUTIES**

- 1. Performs cares specific to each patient's needs, to include:
  - a. Bathing/dressing,
  - b. oral care,
  - c. skin care,
  - d. assisting with feeding patients as needed,
  - e. and/or set up trays.
- 2. Uses good hand washing between patients and patient care activities.
